He was called into actual service by order of the Governor of Maine, and rendezvoused at Augusta Maine, on the South day of March A. D. 1839, being drafted from Captain Pannes Walker's Company of Fifteenen in the Third in said State; and having
The above named Misses Kilg one R, has monthly pay due him from the Sixth day of Misses and subsistence for travel from his residence to the place of rendezvous, and from the place of discharge to his home, being 160 miles, and whatever other allowances are authorized by law, to soldiers so discharged. He is also entitled to pay for clothing during the period of his service: or he has drawn the following articles of clothing, to wit:
the pro rata excess, if any, to be deducted, or the deficiency, if any, to be paid for.
