Dr. The STATE OF MAINE to *Moses Kellogg Jr.* a Sergeant of Captain *David N. Ripley's* Company of *Riflemen* in the Detachment of Troops in actual service from the *Sixth* Division of the Militia of Maine.

PAY, from the <i>sixth</i> day of <i>March</i> to the <i>eighth</i> day of <i>March</i> 1839, inclusive, being <i>three</i> days, at <i>Fifty</i> ⁵⁰ / ₁₀₀ dollars per month,	1.55
DO. for Travel from <i>Lowell</i> the place of my residence, to <i>Augusta</i> the place of my rendezvous; and from <i>Augusta</i> the place of my discharge, to my home, being <i>Eighteen</i> ¹⁸ / ₁₀₀ miles, at <i>Twenty</i> cents per 20 miles,	3.47
SUBSISTENCE, for Travelling, as above, at <i>Twenty</i> cents per 20 miles,	1.60
CLOTHING, allowance, <i>three</i> days, at <i>Five</i> ⁵⁰ / ₁₀₀ dollars per month,25
	\$ 6.87

Received at AUGUSTA, of A. B. THOMPSON, ACTING PAYMASTER GENERAL, this *sixth* day of *November* 1839, the sum of *Six* dollars and *eighty seven* cents, being in full of my pay from the *sixth* day of *March* to the *eighth* day of *March* 1839, and also of my Travelling allowance, of Pay, Subsistence and Clothing, as specified in the above account.
