

Certificate of Discharge.

I hereby Certify, That *Eli Cook* of *Dixmont* Maine, a *Private* of ~~Captain~~ *Ensign James Dunning* Company of ~~in the~~ Detachment commanded by ~~of the~~ drafted Militia of Maine, was born in *Troy* in the State of *Maine* is aged *28* years, *5* feet and *6* inches high, *light* complexion, *gray* eyes, *light* hair, and by profession, when called into actual service by the State of Maine for the protection of its Northeastern Frontier, a *Blacksmith*

He was called into actual service by order of the Governor of Maine, and rendezvoused at *Bangor* Maine, on the *eleventh* day of *March* A. D. 1839, being drafted from Captain *W. G. O. Lockwood* Company of *Infantry* in the *Third* Regiment, ~~Second~~ *Third* Brigade, and *Third* Division of the Militia of Maine, and then residing at *Dixmont* in said State; and having faithfully and honestly served the period required, is now entitled to an honorable discharge.

The above named *Eli Cook* has monthly pay due him from the *eleventh* day of *March* 1839, when last paid by *to include this day*; and he is also entitled to pay and subsistence for travel from his residence to the place of rendezvous, and from the place of discharge to his home, being *40* miles, and whatever other allowances are authorized by law, to soldiers so discharged. He is also entitled to pay for clothing during the period of his service: or he has drawn the following articles of clothing, to wit:

the pro rata excess, if any, to be deducted, or the deficiency, if any, to be paid for.
