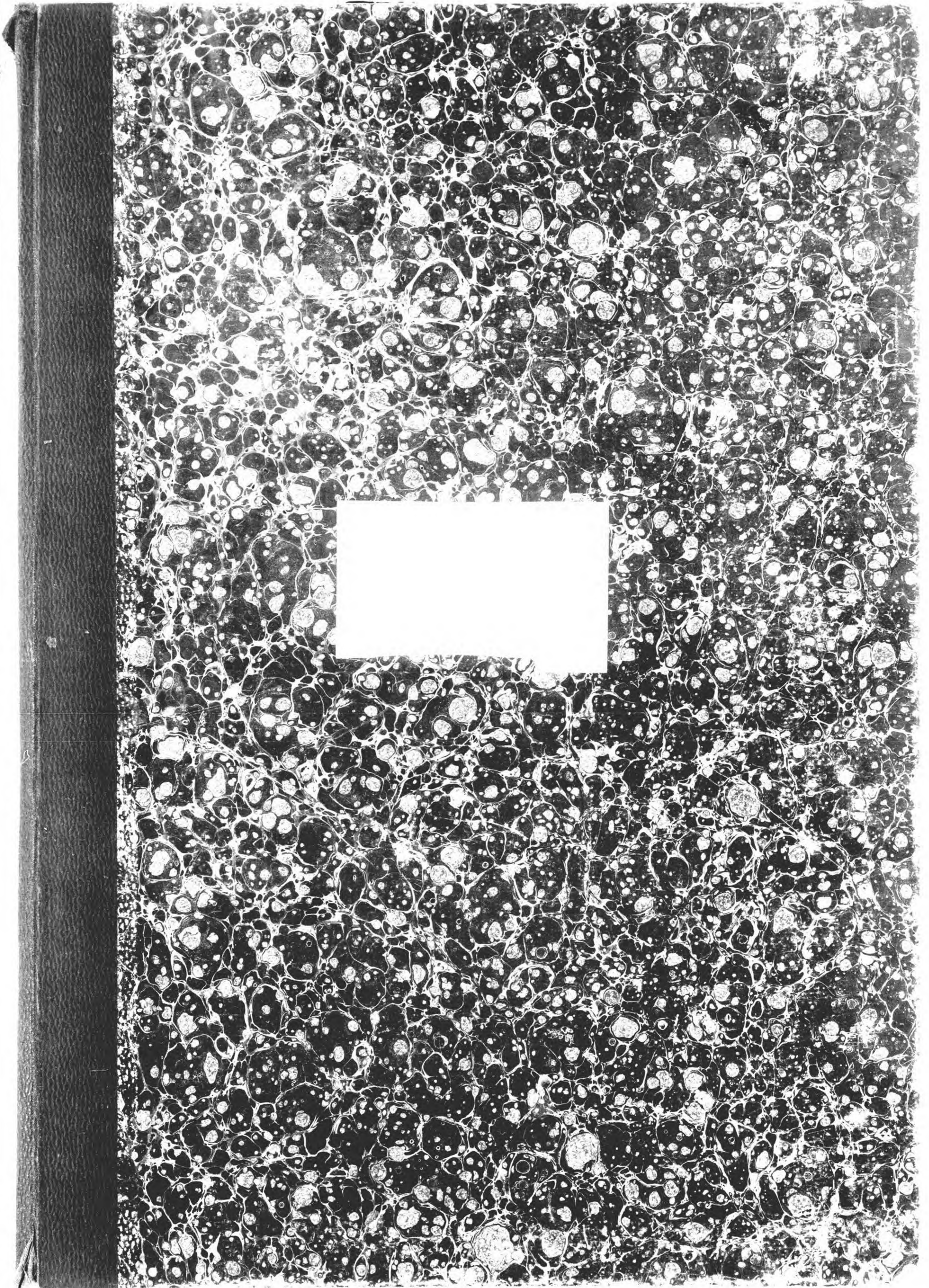

was held on Monday, April 8th, 1901, in the several counties of said
district, for a representative to the Fifty-seventh Congress,

having carefully examined the same

REPORT:

THAT Llewellyn Powers of Houlton appears to have re-
ceived a majority of all the votes cast in the respective counties
and is elected a representative therefor. Llewellyn Powers re-
ceived eight thousand, three hundred and fifty-nine (8,359) votes.

Thomas White received five thousand, five hundred and ninety-
eight (5,598) votes.

Scattering ten (10) votes.
