DO. for Travel from <i>Paris</i> the place of my residence, to <i>Augusta</i> the place of my rendezvous ; and from <i>Augusta</i> the place of my discharge, to my home, being <i>One hundred</i> miles, at <i>Twenty Three</i> ¹ / ₃ cents per 20 miles,	117
SUBSISTENCE , for Travelling, as above, at <i>Twenty</i> cents per 20 miles,	100
CLOTHING , allowance, <i>Three</i> days, at <i>Two</i> ⁵⁰ / ₁₀₀ dollars per month,	95

Received at AUGUSTA, of A. B. THOMPSON, ACTING PAYMASTER GENERAL, this *Third* day of *December* 1839, the sum of *Three*
dollars and *thirty seven* cents, being in full of my pay from the *Sixth* day of *March* to the *eighth* day of *March* 1839, and
also of my Travelling allowance, of Pay, Subsistence and Clothing, as specified in the above account.
