HISTORICAL SKETCH

(Based on the Manual of the Congregational Church of Winthrop, Maine as revised April 18, 1949.)

Of the 264 Maine Congregational Churches listed in the 1947 Year Book, the Winthrop Church is the 23rd oldest, having been organized on September 4, 1776, with 27 Covenant members. It was the first Congregational Church to be organized within the present limits of Kennebec County.

A meeting-house, begun by the town in 1774, was never finished, so services were largely held in private homes. This unfinished house was sold in 1774, and the town voted to build a meeting-house for both parts of the town. The one in the south part of town, Winthrop, was not finished even as late as 1800. In this year, the town having refused to act any longer in ecclesiastical affairs, a poll parish, known as the First Congregational Society of Winthrop, was incorporated by the legislature with the consent of the town. To this society the town turned over the meeting-house on certain conditions, one of which was that it should still be used as a Townhouse. In 1806 the Society was dissolved, the house reverted to the town, which continued to use it as a Townhouse until 1854. In 1800, an orderly succession of Pastors was begun by the ordination of Mr. Jonathan Belden on Aug. 27.

In 1806, the Rev. David Thurston was called as minister of the Church and served until October 15, 1851, during which time he was one of the leading Ministers in the territory. He established what is believed to be the first Sabbath School in New England in 1808, and took an active part in the politics of the Church and State throughout New England. He was a leader of the Temperance and Anti-slavery movements, the latter being the eventual cause of his dismissal since it caused a "division" among the people of the parish. He was affectionately known as "Father Thurston", and a tablet to his memory still adorns the rear wall of the Church Sanctuary.

In 1824, work was started on a third meeting-house, for the first time called a church, and it was dedicated on August 10, 1825. This building still stands on upper Main Street, having been converted into apartments after the Church moved to its present location in 1904.

In 1960, a vestry was built in the center of town at a cost of \$1200. For many years this was used for the Sunday evening and mid-week services of the Church, as well as for its social events. In 1904 this vestry was raised and fitted with stained glass memorial windows. On Sunday, April 5, 1905, it was dedicated as the new Sanctuary of the Church at appropriate services conducted by the Rev. A. K. Baldwin. This building, in which the Church still worships, is the fourth that it has occupied during its 180 years. Its interior was completely remodeled and redecorated in 1945, the design being the creation of Mr. Harry Cochrane, noted Church architect from the neighboring town of Monmouth.

On March 18, 1895, the Church voted to become incorporated under the laws of the State of Maine.

At the present time the Church has 184 members. The Church School has an average attendance of 100. The Pilgrim Fellowship and the Junior-Hi Fellowship are both very well attended. There is also an active Ladies Social Circle which contributes loyally to the support of the Church. The Girl Scout Troop meets weekly in the Church vestry. The Jolly Crowd Club, a social organization comprised of men and women over high school age, meets monthly except during the summer.

A new Hammond Organ was recently installed in the Church Sanctuary. This organ was made possible through the generous giving of the members and friends of the Church and Parish. The Organ Chimes were given as a memorial.

All the committees are very co-operative and attentive to their duties. We are very proud of our two fine choirs. The Senior Choir consists of youth of high school age and the Junior Choir includes children from the fourth through the sixth grades.

At the first meeting of the Diaconate Board for 1957, two Junior Deacons were elected to serve for a period of six months. Their duties will be to take the Love Offering during the Communion Service. At the end of the six months they may be reelected or two others may be chosen. The Junior Deacons elected at this first meeting were Barrie Hammond and Neal Jenkins.

We have a great Congregational heritage; a heritage of courageous dreams and noble actions. The future holds still greater possibilities for our Church; possibilities that can be realized through our efforts for a Church united in vision, prayer, dedication and service in the work of His Kingdom.

THE CHURCH COUNCIL

The Church Council consists of the Moderator as Chairman, the Pastor, the Clerk, Treasurer, Auditor, Superintendent of the Church School, the Chairman of the Various boards and committees, and the Presidents, or their representatives, of the various auxiliary organizations of the Church.

It is the duty of the members to present their plans and programs to the Church Council for its information, and to co-operate with the Pastor in a well-rounded spiritual program of the Church.

SUNDAY SERVICES

Church School 9:30 A. M.

Nursery and Beginners meet at the Parish Rooms.
The Primary Classes meet in the Masonic Building.
The Junior Classes meet in the Church vestry.
The Junior-High and Senior-High Classes meet in the Church Sanctuary.

Because of limited space, the Church School worships in three different buildings. Plans are now being considered for a more satisfactory arrangement for our Church School classes.

Divine Worship 11:00 A. M.

Junior-Hi Fellowship 5:30 P. M.

This Fellowship meets in the Church vestry every Sunday evening, except during the summer months, for a period of worship and fellowship for children from the fifth through the seventh grades.

Pilgrim Fellowship 7:00 P. M.

This is a Fellowship for boys and girls from eighth grade through high school. During the school year, a service is held each Sunday evening in the Church Sanctuary, followed by a game period in the vestry.

LADIES SOCIAL CIRCLE

The first records available for the Ladies Social Circle start in March, 1890, but by the secretary's report of May 7, 1890, an auxiliary had been formed in 1879 in the month of May. The membership at that time was 38. In June 1882, it was voted to aid in the work of the Maine Missionary Society. Soon after this time they aided in the work of the American Missionary Association. This made three distinct organizations. According to the records, nearly five hundred dollars had been earned and sent to these different societies as well as barrels and boxes of clothing to destitute missionaries. It appeared to be strictly a missionary group but a small item from the Winthrop paper states "the Social Circle raised money for home expenditures".

An extract from the records reads: "At times we have been disheartened and almost ready to give up the contest but have not dared. We have all been thrilled by the old crusader's story of the heart of Bruce which was being carried by the Scottish Army, that it might be buried in the Holy City. Overpowered by the Saracens, Douglas, seeing his followers giving way, threw the sacred trust far into the enemies' ranks exclaiming, 'Go thou on, brave heart, as thou didst always go before!' The army rallied and the victory was won. So let us go on remembering that the heart of Christ, not dead but living, has been thrown far before us into the opposing ranks. He is the mighty victor. Let us strive to follow Him and do His bidding."

This seems to have been the incentive which has caused the Ladies Social Circle to continue through the years to be one of the major mainstays of the Church, contributing loyally to its support.

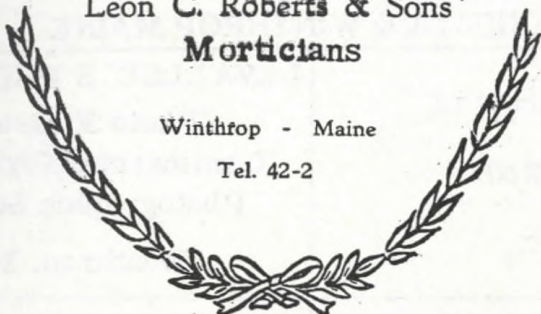
