

Seeds me Aug 5/61

Dr Sir

I herewith send you a copy of Furlough to Henry C. Smith of Seeds who was wounded in the battle before Richmond, has a ball in his side and is now unable to do anything - I have also found to day Lucius C. Robins of Seeds me who Enlisted in the 1st Maine Cavalry in October 1861 - He was taken with Lung Fever and Diphtheria in January 1862 Had a Discharge made out and he says by Capt Boothby and sent to Washington as he says to be signed by someone since which time he has heard nothing from it - He now has some trouble in his Throat and says he is unable to work more than half of the time I have ordered him to report to Augusta immediately
