



4<sup>thly</sup> chose Elihu Robinson clerk sworn.

5<sup>thly</sup> Voted to alter the name of this society so as to read the Readfield Methodist Society.

6<sup>thly</sup> Voted to accept the following articles as a code of by-laws for the management or regulation of this society.

### By-Laws

Section 1<sup>st</sup> there shall be chosen by ballot at their annual meeting in the month of February or March and often if necessary a moderator, clerk, a standing committee of three, Treasurer, and Trustees for their Dwelling and Meeting Houses who shall hold their offices until others are chose and qualified in their stead

### Section 2<sup>nd</sup> Duty of the Moderator

It shall be the duty of the Moderator to presid at all meetings of the Society and to preserve due order and decorum if present but if he is not present then their shall be one chosen in his stead a Moderator pro tempore

### Section 3<sup>rd</sup> Duty of the Clerk

It shall be the duty of the Clerk (who shall be sworn to the faithfull discharge of his duty) to enter and Records all votes and doing of the

## Bye Laws Continued

Society if present but if he is not present then their shall be chosen in his stead a Clerk pro tem (who shall be sworn asforesaid) Also it shall be the duty of the Clerk to enter and record all donations, gifts, grants and bequeath to said Society, and from who, and when, and for what use, and when, and how to be applied and to warne all meeting of the society According to the warrant from the standing committee of the society at least seven days before holding said meeting by posting up a notefcation of the same on the principal outer door of each methodis meeting house in said Readfield Also he shall annually make out a list of all the Rateable pools that belong to the society the first day of May that Reside in said Readfield and Transmit attest copy of the same to the Town Clerk of said Readfield on or before the twentieth day of said may Also he shall on or before the first day of Feb<sup>r</sup> annually transmit to the selectmen of said Readfield a true record of the deviden maid by the standing Committee the proportion of each legal preacher of the gospel of the Methodis Episcopal Church who has officianted in the sevral Methodis houses the year preceeding in said Readfield Also he shall annually or often if necessary make out attest copy of all the Records of said Society kept by him (that has not before been transmitted to their Treasurer) and transmit the same to their Treasurer - Also he shall Record all their Records transmitted to him from their Treasurer attested And if at any time their Record kept by their Clerk should be lost by fire or otherwise then he shall ameadelly have access to their Treasurer Records and forthwith transcribe them all anew in a book keep for that purpose And he shall as soon as may be deliver up to his Successor in that office all the Books papers and documents <sup>of said society</sup> in good order & Condition

### Section 4 th Duty of the Standing Committee

It shall be the duty of the Standing Committee to make out a Warrent for all meetings of said society Except on adjument and Super tend all

(when he holds property of the society) and report the same to the society  
at their annually meeting Also to draw all orders on the Treasurer agreeable  
to the Vote of the society and make a deviden annually on or before the  
Twentyeth day of January the payement of each legal Preacher of the gosp-  
el of the Methodist Episcopal Church who have officiated in the several Metho-  
dis meeting houses in said Readfield the year proceeding of the towns money  
that belonget to said Preachers

### SECTION 5<sup>th</sup> Duty of the Treasurer

It shall be the duty of the Treasurer (who shall give Bonds when required  
by said society or the standing Committee with sufficient securities) to Recieve  
and Record all moneys and effects deeds and securities due owing or coming  
to said society and demand sue for and recover the same in their name  
(unless prohibited by them) and he shall have the care and Custody of all  
the moneys obligation for money and effects and deeds belonging to said Society &  
shall not dispose of the same only by an order in writing from the standing  
Committee Also in case of <sup>the</sup> death Resignation absent or inability of the Clerk  
it shall be the duty of the Treasurer to notify and warn the the meeting of  
said society in the same manner and under the same circumstance as the Clerk  
is Required to in section 3<sup>rd</sup>. Also he shall annually or oftened if necessary  
make out attested copy of all the Records of said society kept by him (that  
has not before been transmitted to their Clerk) and transmit the same to their  
Clerk and he shall Record of the Records transmitted to him from their Clerk attested  
and at any time the Records of this society kept by their Treasurer should be lost by  
fire or otherwise he shall amedely have access to their Clerk Records and fourth-  
with transcribe them all anew in a Book kept for that purposous also

Also he shall render a full and Regearly statement annually of all the property and evidence of property in his hands belonging to said society and officer if Required by said society or their standing Committee Also he shall deliver through the inspection of the standing committee up to his Successor in that office all the property and evidence of property of whatsoever name or nature of said society in his hands with all the book and papers in good order & condishon as soon as may be

Section 6 the Duty of the Trustees

It shall be the duty of the Trustees to do the same duty to and for their house and meeting house they are chosen for either to build or Repare as is the Trustees of the Methodist Episcopal church are Required to do as described in their form of discipline for their Meeting houses and in no other way except the meeting houses is pewed then to be deeded to the new holders by Reserving to said church to hold ~~and~~ Occupy and improve the house agreeable to their form of discipline for their meeting houses & in no other way

### Section 7<sup>th</sup>

The standing Committee and Trustees in These bye laws shall at all times be members of said Methodist Episcopal Church and their duty shall always be the same as pointed out for them in the forth and sixth Section in thesee bye Laws (Except as to keep with in the Lawes of the state of Maine and said Church discipline) Also this Society shall never Rose money by Assement or taxation and it shall never be in the power of this Society to Alter this seventh Section of thesee bye lawes by adding to or diminishing or Repealing any of it unless everie member of this society at this annually meeting be present and Vote for the same

Section 8<sup>th</sup> The aforesaid Bye laws contained in first, second, third and fifth Section shall not be Altered by adding to or diminished unless three fourth of this society that are present at a Legal meeting Vote for the same T chose
