The above named Thomas Hersey has monthly pay due him from the 5 4th day of March 1839, when last paid by to the eighth being then discharged he certificate to include this day; and he is also entitled to pay and subsistence for travel from his residence to the place of rendezvous, and from the place of discharge to his home, being this piece miles, and whatever other allowances are authorized by law, to soldiers so discharged. He is also entitled to pay for clothing during the period of his service: or he has drawn the following articles of clothing, to wit:
