 Company of *Infantry* in the Detachment of Troops in actual service from the *Sixth*
 Division of the Militia of Maine.

PAY, from the <i>Sixth</i> day of <i>March</i> to the <i>ninth</i> day of <i>March</i> 1839, being <i>four</i> days, at <i>Nine ⁵⁰/₁₀₀</i> dollars per month,	127
DO. for Travel from <i>Fryeburg</i> the place of my residence, to <i>Augusta</i> the place of my rendezvous; and from <i>Augusta</i> the place of my discharge, to my home, being <i>One hundred</i> <i>eighty</i> miles, at <i>Twenty Three ¹³/₁₀₀</i> cents per 20 miles,	2.10
SUBSISTENCE, for Travelling, as above, at <i>Twenty</i> cents per 20 miles,	1.80
CLOTHING, allowance, <i>four</i> days, at <i>Two ⁵⁰/₁₀₀</i> dollars per month,	33
	\$ 5.50

Received at AUGUSTA, of A. B. THOMPSON, ACTING PAYMASTER GENERAL, this *fourth* day of *January* 1840, the sum of *Five*
 dollars and *fifty* cents, being in full of my pay from the *sixth* day of *March* to the *ninth* day of *March* 1839, and
 also of my Travelling allowance, of Pay, Subsistence and Clothing, as specified in the above account.
