Athens October 28th 1820

To his Excellency William King

Sir I take the liberty to inform you that there has been several petitions circulating in this neighborhood for Joseph Carr Esq to be made Sleigh Sheriff of the County of Penobscot the circumstances of which I would beg leave to represent. Said petitions were written by

Francis Carr Brother to Joseph Carr and went round by asking him who represented that General Sleath must inevitably go out of office and that unless we signed his petitions we should without doubt have a person less suitable to fill said office.

My neighbors say that they have been deceived many of them that they did not know what they were signing that they would

like to have General Shirck con-
tinued in office and that if it was
not for an appearance of inconsistency
they would sign a petition to that
effect.
