William Cowpin in and upon the good Sloop  
Elizabeth, wheres is master under God for this  
present Voyage William Cowpin and now at  
anchor in the Port of York, and by Gods Grace  
Bounde to St Croix that is to say Forty Five  
Thoun four hundred Fifty Six feet of merchantable  
Pine Boards Planks and Joys Eighteen  
Thousand & of Pine Shingle Two Thousand  
Eight Hundred an half of white Oak Sh.  
Flower Sixty Five Shooks Sh. Red Oak  
Eight Oxen & Eight Horses Three Quarter  
Part of which are on the proper Account and  
Prize of the said Thomas Fletcher & Jonathan  
Lor, and the other ~~Two~~ Quarter on the proper  
Account & Prize of the said William. The said  
three Quarters are to be delivered in the like  
good Order and Well Condition at the aforesaid  
Port of St Croix (the Danger of the Seas only  
except) unto the said Jonathan Lor or to his  
assigns he or they paying Freight for the same  
Three Quarters nothing. In Witness wheres  
the said Master ~~of~~ of the said Sloop, hath  
affirmed to Two Bills of Lading of this Tenor  
and Date the one of which being accomplished  
the other Two to be Void and so god send the  
good Sloop to her desired Port in Safety amen
