Dear Sir

I find

Wm. Allen Gray - Co. I. Me. 10th with a furlough dated July 23 extending 30 days. It is signed by order of Maj. M. Scott, Provost-Marshal Hagerstown Md. - Capt. W. J. Byrnes Dep. Prov. Marsh. He goes to his reg't - this week.

Capt. Royall F. Nash ^{Gray} Co. H. 11th has returned to his reg't.

Dan. M. Dill of Gray, & his brother William, of Co. H. 11th were both taken prisoners in one of the battles before Richmond & have not been heard from since.

Benj. F. Goodwin - Cornish - Co. K. 9th reg't - reported by you "Prisoner at Raleigh", is paroled & I found him at work in a stable at Baldwin. I ordered him to report at Augusta, & he has promised to go next Monday.

Albert W. Church - Bridgton - Co. I. 10th Me. Discharged at Baltimore by command of Maj. Gen. Dix - D. T. Van Buren. A. A. G. May 14th 1862

Rayall L. Dodge - Bridgton Co. E. 12th regt - Discharged
by ^{St. Col.} Wm. K. Kimball - Apr. 11-'62. Given
at Ship Island - approved by order of
Maj. Gen. Butler, Geo. C. Strong, A. A. G.

Caleb A. Chaplin - Bridgton - Co. E. 12th is at home, well,
says he has a discharge, but was obliged
to send it to N. Y. to get his back pay.
I know him well, & have no doubt his
story is true. He has promised to bring
his discharge to me next week. If there
is any thing different - I will tell you.

Charles C. Newland, Harrison - Co. D. 15th is at Saw-
rence at work in a factory - so I have
not seen him - but his family &
Nathaniel H. Leavy, Harrison - Co. D. 15th say, that he
has a discharge just like Leavy's -
both signed at Augusta - June 14th
1862; by Maj. J. W. T. Gardiner.

Geo. Hill - Harrison, Co. I. 10th Me. Gone to Michigan.
His family say he had a good discharge.

George Carsley, Harrison } Co. D. 15th minors -
enlisted without consent of their
fathers - ^{Deserters} I learn that Maj. Gardiner's
clerk - Furbish has visited them, & look-
ed into their case, & told them that they
were not holden - there was nothing
for them to do. Geo. Pierce of H. went

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with Farbish & corroborates their statement,
Moses M. Keene, Harrison. Co D. 15th reg't. Discharge
given at Augusta. June 14th 1862 signed
