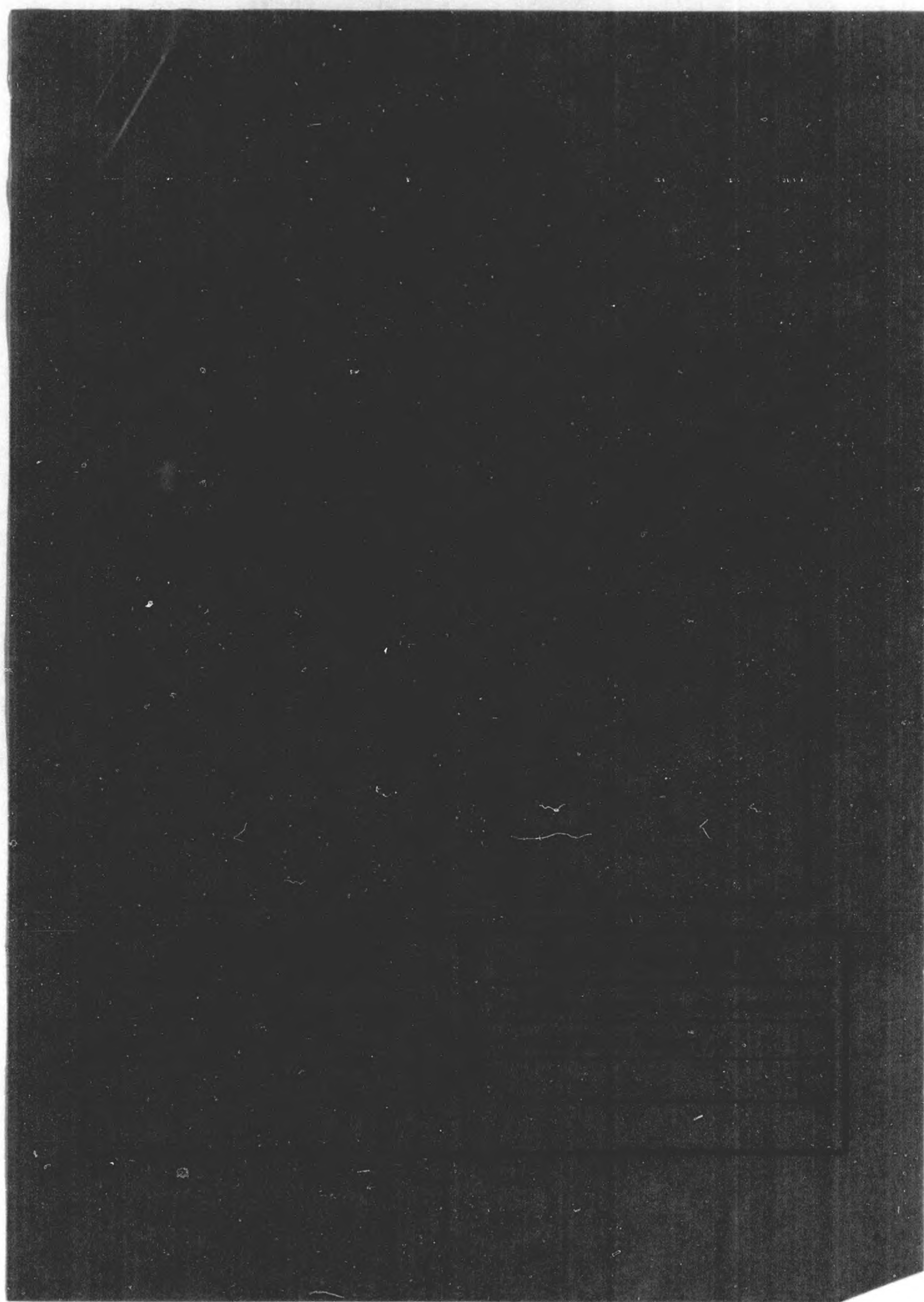

Statement of Facts

An inspection of the ballots cast for the office of Representative to the Legislature from the towns of Grand Isle and Van Buren was requested by Charles L. O'Connell and was held on December 14, 1956. It was found that Charles L. O'Connell received 314 votes instead of 313 and Vital E. Violette received 317 votes instead of 316. Both parties have agreed in writing to the above tabulation and the purpose of this order is to make the agreed tabulation official.
