I think that Mr. Salisbury is a deserter or has any intent to evade duty he came home sick and is now quite lame of Rheumatism is willing to do anything Government requires of him. so far as he is able - he has handled some British sympathies in Trenton rather roughly since he returned. and from thence I presume sparing the report you have of him. I think it might be well enough for him to report in person at Augusta which he is willing to do -
