(Dear Sir)

I was yesterday after, Woodbury,
 I found him in 57 Athens,
 After a good deal of bluster &
 swagger finding I was in earnest
 he said he had papers & would
 away in Hartford, I told him
 to get into my wagon & we would
 go towards them. He finally concluded
 to look in his satchel which he has
 with him, he there found his
 discharge from Pa 110 regt in
 which he was enrolled the 23rd Sept/61
 Discharged for Chronic Pleurisy June
 17th/62 at Front Royal
 Signed David Copelan Colonel Co K
 110th regt. By command of Genl McDowell
 He has up to this time insisted that he
 had no papers & object maine authorisation
 He, His object was to enlist again &

and obtain the large bounty & then ⁶¹⁷
get an other discharge,
At St Spague St Albans has return
to his regt, Alon O A Millet
of Palmyra Sprague has just been
paroled from Richmond where he has
been ever since Bull Run. Both
he & Millet are patriots of the
true grit & will do there duty
when possible,

I will do my best to hunt
up sculkers as you suggest,
I have returned many & a
few have run away. Though I
know of but 3 yet for certainty
