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**AN ACT Amending the Maine Employment Security Law as to Seasonal Employment.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 29, § 21, sub-§ I, amended.** Subsection I of section 21 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

**'I.** As used in this section the ~~term~~ **terms** "seasonal industry" and "seasonal occupation" ~~means mean~~ an occupation or industry in which, because of the seasonal nature thereof it is customary to operate only during a regularly recurring period or periods of less than 40 weeks in a calendar year. The Commission ~~shall must after investigation and hearing investigate, hold hearings, determine, and may shall~~ thereafter from time to time redetermine, the longest seasonal period or periods during which, by the best practice of the occupation or industry in question, operations are conducted. ~~Until such determination by the commission, no occupation or industry shall be deemed seasonal.'~~
