AN ACT Authorizing the Establishment of Private Game Preserves.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 150-A, additional. Chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 150-A, to read as follows:

'Private Game Preserves.

Sec. 150-A. Establishment of private game preserves. Any owner of land may enclose and post such land, not in excess of 400 acres, as a private game preserve. He may stock said preserve with wild birds and animals and notwithstanding any laws to the contrary may hunt and permit the hunting of said wild birds and animals, either privately or commercially.'
