Although persons intrusted with public buisness supposed to be aware that the land situated on the sea in this state is generally far less valuable and productive than land in the interior yet we deem it proper to make the following statement in regard to Westport in particular

1<sup>ly</sup> The mowing tillage, and paster land of this town has a shoal soil and is weaker than the Generally on the seaboard it is mostly a gravelly soil some some of it sandy a small part of it only being of a clayey loam. it is a thirsty soil and suffers twenty five per cent more from drought than land in the interior does

2<sup>ly</sup> The wood and unimproved land of this town is of trifling value, our ~~lot~~ lots consists of only a second growth of scrubby far spruces, and pine seldom a tree coming up to the size of fifteen inches in diameter

3<sup>ly</sup> The unimprovable or waste land of Westport consists of ledges and sinking bogs which are worthless it amounts to about one third part of the town This subjects us to much inconvenience, for it is so mixed up with the other land that we have to be at the expence of enclosing a large piece of territory for a small piece of tillage mowing or or pasturing it is therefore quite worse than useless being a drawback on the value of our other land
