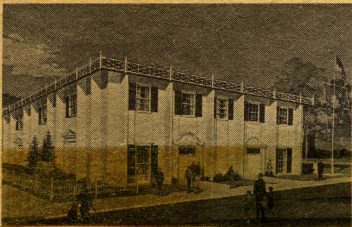

## AS MAINE GOES . . .

The Maine pavilion at Expo 67, which opens this month in Montreal, is a \$165,000 colonial-style structure executed in prestressed concrete (rendering below). Not



surprisingly, its design has caused some repercussions among architects of the state.

A survey conducted by the *Portland Sunday Telegram* revealed that "some architects are dissatisfied with the motif" of the building. One anonymous architect was quoted as saying it would make Maine "the laughing stock of the nation and the world." It seems a safe enough prediction.
