Honored Sir

I respectfully call
your attention to the recent changes in The
10th Regiment of Volunteers from your State.

Captain George W. West, late
Captain of Company D in that Regiment has
been promoted Major by your Command, in
the 14th Regiment, now forming in Maine.

1st Lieutenant John S. Beardley
Co D 10th Regt, I hear is quite ill, and
an informer does not desire the Command
of said Company, for reason of a want
of Confidence in his Competency; and I
understand moreover that Captain
West proposed to your excellency the
name of Edward Brackett 1st Sergeant
Co D, for the Captaincy of Company D.

I beg leave to state here, that
Mr Brackett is an accomplished and
honorable gentleman and fully, is he
Competent to fill that position and
Should your Excellency deem proper

to appoint said Brackett he will prove
himself an honor to the Regiment to
the service and the State. Mr Brackett
~~simply~~ desires the rank of but a simple
Lieutenant. the rank of a gentleman.

I there fore respectfully
apply to your excellency for the Captaincy
of Company D 10th Maine Regt now
vacant by the Promotion or Capt Ires W.
West.

I have no great ambition for
high Military Office, more than I can
attain by honorable merit, or more than
that which I am entitled to by the regular
routine of succession in promotions in
Companies or Regiments to a vacancy.

My being detached on
Special duty at a different post, I conceive,
does not, or should not exempt me from
holding my proper position or the promotion
to which I am entitled by a vacancy in
a higher position, which may occur in
my own Company - Your Excellency
has on file some highly commendatory
papers in my favor from Col. Gen O'Baston
Sethens of High Military position of Mass^{lt}.
and should any other person under me
in my Company be promoted to the Capt^y
of my Company - I should deem it a

slight, an injustice, and a discredit to
my known standing in regard to
my competency in military circles
and would tend to injure me
to a great extent.

I therefore, beg your
Excellency, under the circumstances
to consider my application favorably
and that you will deem proper
to issue my Commission as Captain
of Company D 1st Maine from the
date of Capt West's acceptance or
his promotion.

Should your Excellency
honor me to a field Officer's position for
which I have previously applied - I will
then respectfully recommend that
Sergt Edward Brackett receive his
Commission as Capt of Co D, and
if you should honor me with the
latter position & that Mr Brackett
be either 1st or 2nd Lieut.
