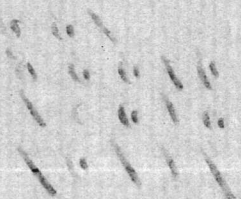
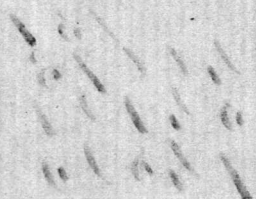
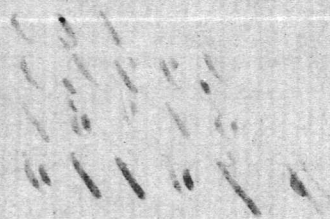

General Proprietors and Inhabitants of Westport in the County of Lincoln taken pursuant to An Act of the Legislature, approved on the fourth day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-nine, entitled "An Act in relation to the State Valuation," by the subscribers, Assessors of said Westport duly elected and sworn: and the said Assessors in fixing a value upon the property hereafter enumerated have been governed by "the full, fair cash value thereof" as directed in the Act aforesaid.

STATE OF MAINE.

AN ACT in relation to the State Valuation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The assessors of each city, town and plantation in this state, for the current year, shall at the time provided by law for that purpose, make a true and accurate list of all the male polls of twenty-one years of age and upwards, resident in or belonging to said city, town or plantation, whether such persons are at home or abroad, distinguishing such as are exempted from taxation; and shall also make true and accurate lists of all ratable estates, both real and personal, (not exempt by law from paying state taxes,) lying or being within their several cities, towns or plantations, and all such estates or property of whatever kind, wherever situated or located, which is subject to be taxed in said cities, towns or plantations, and said assessors shall affix to said estates and property of whatever kind, enumerated and set forth in said lists, the full, fair cash value thereof.

SECT. 2. The assessors of every city, town and plantation, shall submit to the full and free examination of the commissioners on state valuation, provided for by resolves of this legislature, at the time and place designated by said commissioners, all said lists of polls and valuation for this year, or such full and accurate abstracts thereof, as said commissioners shall require and direct; and shall also produce or cause to be produced before said commissioners, for their examination, at the time and place designated as aforesaid, the full original poll lists and valuation lists of their several cities, towns and plantations, for the years eighteen hundred and fifty-seven, eighteen hundred and fifty-eight, and eighteen hundred and fifty-nine.

SECT. 3. And the assessors of the several cities, towns and plantations, for the year eighteen hundred and fifty-nine, shall make out their valuation and tax lists of all taxable property in their several localities, at the full value thereof, as aforesaid, and before said lists thus prepared, shall be transmitted to the commissioners aforesaid, the said assessors shall make oath or affirmation to the facts as to the manner in which said tax and valuation lists were made up, and shall subscribe a certificate of said oath, upon said lists, duly attested, and if any assessors shall refuse or neglect to comply with the requirements of this act, he shall for each offence forfeit and pay a fine of not less than fifty nor more than two hundred dollars.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect from and after its approval by the governor.

[Approved April 4, 1859.]

RESOLVES to provide for a State Valuation.

Resolved, That the governor is hereby authorized, with the advice and consent of the council, to appoint a commission, to consist of seven persons, one from each councilor district to prepare a full, just and equal valuation of the state, with an enumeration of all the polls subject to be taxed, as a basis of taxation for state purposes for the ensuing decade commencing with the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty.

Resolved, That the commissioners thus chosen may hold a session at the capitol in Augusta, on the tenth day of October next, first giving public and sufficient notice of the time and place of said meeting requiring the assessors or some one of them of each city, town and plantation to

appear personally with, or to transmit to them on said day their several tax and valuation lists, and lists of taxable polls of their several cities, towns and plantations for the years eighteen hundred and fifty-seven, eighteen hundred and fifty-eight and eighteen hundred and fifty-nine, which lists shall be made out and verified under oath. And at any meeting of said board of commissioners, regularly and properly notified, a majority of the members thereof shall constitute a quorum, and said commissioners may appoint a chairman from their own number to preside over the sittings of the board, and also may choose a clerk, to keep a fair record of its proceedings.

Resolved, That if from any city, town or plantation no member of the board of assessors shall appear at the time and place fixed in the public notice by the commissioners, or transmit the lists named in the preceding resolve, the said commissioners may, in their discretion, proceed to doom such city, town or plantation to the payment of such proportion and amount of the state tax as they shall deem just and equitable, both on the valuation and poll lists.

Resolved, That said board of commissioners shall prepare full and accurate lists of all the cities, towns and plantations wherein the valuation shall be equalized throughout the state, in such manner that taxation for state purposes founded thereon for the next decade, shall be just and equal as nearly as may be throughout the state. And said commissioners shall complete their lists of valuation on or before the first day of January, eighteen hundred and sixty, and when completed they shall be forthwith delivered by the chairman of the commissioners to the state treasurer, who shall safely keep them, subject to the order of the next legislature.

Resolved, That the land agent be required to prepare and deliver to said board of commissioners, full and accurate lists of all townships, parts of townships, blocks, and lots of wild lands in the state which have been sold by the state, and which have not yet been included in the tax lists of the state; and the lists so prepared shall state the fair valuation of all lands described or stated therein. And these lists shall contain a statement of all lands which have been actually sold as aforesaid, whether deeds of conveyance have passed or not. Also a statement of all lands on which the timber has been sold or right to cut timber granted for any number of years, which right to cut timber, leases and all other interest therein shall be appraised at their just value.

Resolved, That the first meeting of the board of commissioners, for purposes of organization, shall be held at the office of the state treasurer, at Augusta, on the tenth day of October, and notice of the time and place of said meeting shall be sent by mail by the treasurer to each of the commissioners at least one week before the day of meeting.

Resolved, That as a full compensation for services rendered in the execution of their duty, said commissioners and clerk shall be entitled to receive from the treasury of the state two dollars per day each while actually engaged in the duties of the commission, and the same travel allowed to a representative. And the governor, after examination and approval by the council of the accounts of said commissioners and their clerk, for services and travel as aforesaid, shall be authorized to draw his warrant upon the treasurer in payment of the same.

Resolved, That it shall be the duty of the secretary of state to prepare and furnish to each city, town and plantation the necessary blanks to carry into effect the provisions of the foregoing resolves.

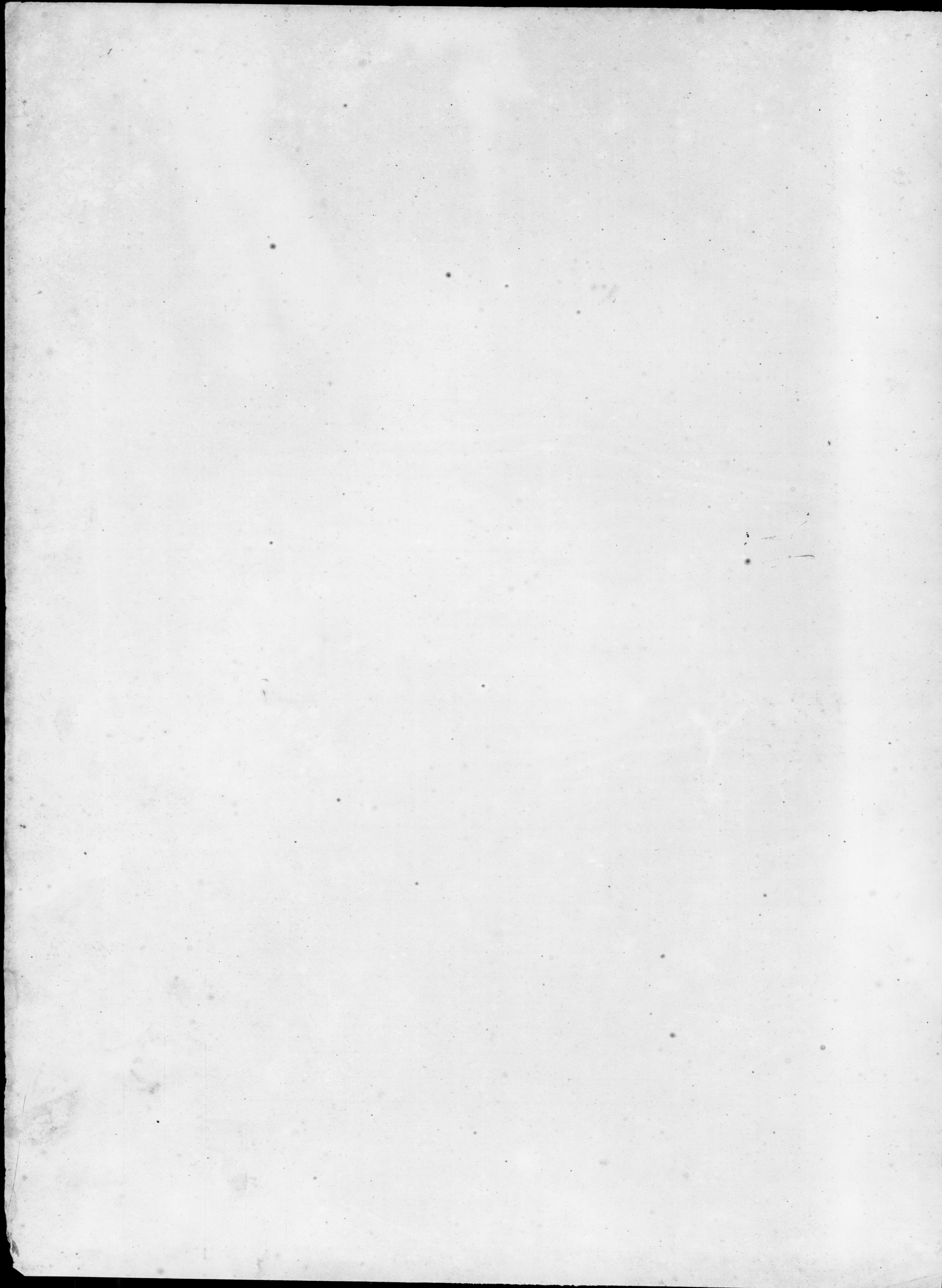
