At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Brooksville, in the County of Hancock, qualified to vote for Senators, holden on the first Monday of December, being the sixth day of said month A.D. 1819. for the purpose of giving in their votes in writing, expressing their approbation or disapprobation of the Constitution prepared by the Convention of Delegates assembled at Portland on the second Monday of October last pursuant to an Act entitled "An Act relating to the Separation of the District of Maine from Massachusetts proper, and forming the same into a separate and independent State"

The whole number of votes given in, in said town, were sorted, and counted in the open meeting of the town, by the Selectmen, who presided at said meeting, and were Eighteen . . . . . of which Seven . . . . .  
were in favour of the Constitution prepared by the Convention as aforesaid, and Seven . . . . .  
were opposed to <sup>said</sup> Constitution.
