Directions

Lewiston: Gray Athletic Building, Bates College: *From the South or North:* Take the Maine Turnpike to Exit 13, at end of exit ramp turn north, toward Lewiston. Go straight through the light on Alfred Plourde Pkwy, keeping the Ramada Inn on the left. At Webster St, a "T" intersection, turn left. Follow Webster St. to East Ave, about 1 1/8 mis. Turn right. Follow East Ave, through one set of lights to Russell St. Turn left. Pass Lafayette St. on the left, go on to Central Ave. Turn left onto Central Ave. Approaching the Campus Ave. intersection, watch for signs for the Gray Athletic building, the site of the conference.

From Main St. in Lewiston: At CMMC, turn right onto Rt. 126/Sabattus St. (left if coming from the north). Travel a few blocks to Central Ave. and turn left. Approaching the Campus Ave. intersection, watch for signs for the Gray Athletic building, the site of the conference.

Portland: Holiday Inn by the Bay, 88 Spring St. From Rt. 1295: Take Exit 7. Turn toward downtown Portland on the Franklin Arterial from the exit ramp. Follow the Franklin Arterial up the hill to Middle St. Turn right onto Middle St. which becomes Spring St. at Temple, go straight. There is a public parking garage near the Civic Center on the right. The Holiday Inn is ahead on the left, across from the YWCA.

Bangor: Spectacular Events Center, 395 Griffin Rd. From Rt. 195: Take Exit 47 turn right onto Union St. if coming from the north, left if coming from the south. Follow Union St. to Griffin Rd, where the Airport Mall is located. Turn left onto Griffin Rd, Spectacular Events is ahead on the right near the intersection of Maine Ave.

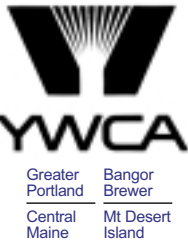
