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At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of  
Harpowell in the county of Cumberland qualified to vote  
for senators holden on the first monday of December being  
sixth day of said month AD 1819 for the purpose of giving  
in their votes in writing expressing their Approbation  
or Disapprobation of the constitution prepared by the  
convention of Delegates assembled at Portland on the second  
monday of october last pursuant to an act entitled an act  
Relating to the separation of the District of maine from  
Massachusetts ~~proper~~ & forming the same into  
a separate & independent State

The whole number of votes given in said town  
were sorted & counted in the open meeting of the town  
by the selectmen who presided at said meeting & were  
eighteen of which ten were in favor of the constitution  
prepared by the convention as aforesaid & eight  
were opposed to said constitution

the foregoing is a true copy of the record as entered in  
open meeting in the Books of the town
