ADVISORY COMMISSION

Traffic Ordinance Part 5, section 5-177:
"Required Obedience" Except when otherwise directed by a police officer, or other authorized person, the driver of any vehicle and every pedestrian shall obey the instructions of any traffic control device, signal, sign or marker, installed under the provisions of this ordinance or State Law, and every person shall obey each and every provision of this ordinance.

section 5-178 "True name to be given"

It shall be unlawful for any person when given a notice by any police officer or other authorized person to appear to answer for an offense against any provision of this ordinance by giving other than his true name and true place of his residence or address. upon the request of such police officer or other authorized person.

section 5-179 "Penalty"

Every person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not more than one hundred dollars. All such fines shall be recovered by complaint and shall be for the use of the town and entered in the town treasury.

section 5-182 "Exercise of Police Power"

This entire ordinance shall be deemed and construed to be an exercise of the Police Power of the town of Old Orchard Beach for the preservation and protection of public safety, and all of its provisions shall liberally construed with a view to the effectuation of such purpose.

section 5-165 "Erect signs where required"

Whenever any time limit parking is imposed, except when specifically exempted, and wherever a one-way street is established, the Public Works Department shall erect appropriate signs giving notice thereof, and no such regulations shall be effective until and unless said signs are erected.

Maine Delegation Announcements

The Office of Education has made grants and grant allocations to Maine totaling \$7.9 million for education aid to low income students and the handicapped, the Maine congressional delegation announced Wednesday.

The bulk of the money--\$6.6 million-- is reserved for local school systems for education in low income areas. The allocations by county are: Androscoggin, \$519,455; Aroostook, \$1,084,561; Cumberland, \$951,071; Franklin, \$102,342; Hancock, \$242,259; Kennebec, \$485,177; Knox, \$193,312; Lincoln, \$159,858; Oxford, \$298,621; Penobscot, \$783,468; Piscataquis, \$109,758; Sagadahoc, \$165,955; Somerset, \$357,290; Waldo, \$199,740; Washington, \$311,475; York, \$561,974; there is \$150,000 set aside for administrative costs.

In addition, Maine is one of 21 states to receive special incentive grants for school districts in most urgent need of additional money. Money available to Maine under this program totals \$354,898. The special incentive grant program is designed to help those states which contribute a larger than average share of personal income to education.

Grants from the Bureau of Education for the Handicapped for state operated programs for handicapped children in Maine total \$730,816, while money for state agencies for education of neglected or delinquent children totals \$175,000.

The Maine delegation announced that the U.S. Public Health Service has allotted \$80,370 to various nursing schools in Maine for student loan and scholarship programs. Scholarship funds total \$34,071, while loans amount to \$46,299.

The Law Enforcement Assistance Administration has awarded \$112,030 in Law Enforcement Education Program funds, the Maine congressional delegation announced. The money will be shared by the University of Maine campuses at Gorham, Urono, Augusta, Machias and Presque Isle, and the Southern Maine Vocational Technical Institute. Money is to be used for student loans and grants.

The Farmers Home Administration has approved a \$250,000 loan to Knox County for renovation of the county jail, and a \$24,000 loan to the Town of Lamoine for fire protection, the Maine congressional delegation announced.

The General Services Administration has declared the Whitlock Mills Light Station at Calais surplus to federal needs. The announcement came through the Maine congressional delegation.

The property includes four buildings on 1.6 acres of land. The GSA reports that the Town of Calais has expressed an interest in the property for a park.

EVENTS IN Scarborough

Scarborough Downs will be the scene of some of Maine's top harness racing ever the next seven day's, as the local harness strip will be offering a total \$12,420 in purses for three events. Kicking off the racing spectacular will be a \$ 2,500 purse invitational on Saturday, August 14th, which has attracted entries from as far away as Pennsylvania who will be competing against against some top local talent for one trip to the winner's circle.

Leading the field with a life-time mark of 1.59 1/5th set at Foxboro will be Buffalo Ben. The six year old gelding also owns Scarborough's 1976 record of 202 2/5ths which he set in his only local visit.

Cindy's Band, a three year old colt for the Bay State, will be pulling driver Bob Tisbert over the course, looking to get his picture taken and improvising his 2:00 4/5ths mark. It is the first year of racing for the youngster who has registered three wins, three seconds, and three show finishes in 13 trips to post. Another Massachusettes entry, Chief Kraft, has a life time of 2:04 3/5, but was recently a dead heatplace finisher in the computed time of 2:01 1/5ths. Dennis May will be driving the six year old.

Roundino out the field of pacers will be Countermaid, traveling from Gorham, New Hampshire, this six year old has a 2:04 1/5mark, but has a computed show marks in 1976 of 2:01 4/5ths. Granite State entry, Volatile, drew the three hole, for the feature. Volatile has a 2:00- marks and leads the field in money earned with \$47,780, he also recently scored a 2:06 1/5th victory on an "of" N.H. track. Maine's only entry in the invitational is a race Me Stable's Beast oot who sports a 2:04 1/5 lifetime and \$42422 in total earnings. The field is considered by Scarborough ofricials as being one for the best ever assembled at the sea-side oval, and with competition like this, a new track record should certinaly be a consideration.

The week's action does not end on Saturday, as Scarborough will be hosting the seconf leg of the New England Sire Stakes on Wednesday and Thurssday, August 18th and 19th. On Wednesday, the two year olds will be pacing for \$4,666 and Thursdat action for three years old will be for \$5,452. Also on Wednesday, twelve top New England Sires will be on show on the uld paddock and will parade om the track prior to the evenings racing scheoule.

All in all, it is great week for racing fans; a chance to see some of the area's beat pacers on Saturday, and next Wednesday and Thursday New Englands best youngsters will head to post..

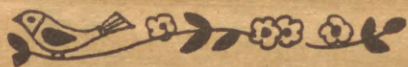
The Civil Community Theatre group is presenting a dramatics workshop on Sat. August 14, 1976 at Saco City Hall.
