## ROAD & SIDEWALK ADVISORY COMMISSION

Traffic Ordinance Part 6:

section 5-118

"Stopping, standing, or parking prohibited at specific locations."

No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle in any of the following places, nor shall any person move a vehicle not owned by him into any of the said places, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer, other authorized person, or traffic control device:

- (1) On a sidewalk.
- (2) In front of a public or private driveway.
- (3) Within an intersection.
- (4) Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.
- (5) On a crosswalk.
- (6) Within 20 feet of the near corner of the curbs at an intersection.
- (7) Within 30 feet upon the approach to any flashing beacon, stop sign, or traffic control signal located at the side of a roadway.
- (8) Alongside or opposite any street excavation or obstruction when such stopping, standing or parking would obstruct traffic.
- (9) On the roadway side of any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb or a street or double park, so-called.
- (10) Upon any bridge.
- (11) Any place where official signs prohibit stopping.

# MARY'S MORSELS

Here is a delicious way to cook eggplant. If you are asked to donate to a covered dish supper in your church or club, try this recipe.

## EGGPLANT CASSEROLE (MOUSAKA)

- |                              |                                     |
|------------------------------|-------------------------------------|
| 2 medium eggplants           | 1 cup water                         |
| 2 tbsp. minced parsley       | 3/4 cup grated cheese (Romano)      |
| 2 medium onions, chopped     | 1/2 stick butter                    |
| 1/2 cup tomato paste         | 1/2 cup olive oil (Mazzola will do) |
| 2 eggs, well beaten          |                                     |
| 1 lb. chopped meat (hamburg) |                                     |
| 1/2 cup bread crumbs         |                                     |
| salt and pepper to taste     |                                     |

Brown the meat and onion in the oil, add the water and tomato paste, parsley, butter, salt and pepper, simmer on low fire until paste is thickened. Peel and cut the eggplant lengthwise about 1/4 inch thick slices, roll in flour and saute in oil or butter to a golden brown color. Add two tablespoons of the breadcrumbs to the meat mixture and blend well. Butter a baking dish well and sprinkle with breadcrumbs. Place half of eggplant sliced in the dish and spread half of chopped meat on the eggplant slices. Add remaining eggplant and chopped meat alternately. Pour well beaten eggs on top and spread evenly. Sprinkle with grated cheese and bread crumbs and bake in medium oven for about half an hour or until golden brown.

# ORONO

ORONO--The University of Maine at Orono will start its 109th academic year Wednesday, Sept. 8, with a total enrollment of 11,208--the same overall enrollment registered at UMO in 1975-76.

Of the total enrollment, some 9600 will be fulltime day students with the remainder being Continuing Education Division enrollees. The incoming freshman class will number 2050, the same as last year, according to admissions officials.

When it opened Sept. 21, 1868, as the State College of Agriculture and the Mechanic Arts, the University had 12 students and two faculty members. UMO now has more than 600 faculty members.

The 2050 freshmen were admitted from more than 7500 applicants.

Dormitories will open for undergraduate students at both the Orono and Bangor campuses Tuesday, Sept. 7, at 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Orono students may register at Lengyel Gymnasium and Bangor campus students at Eastport Hall.

New freshmen and transfer students who did not attend summer orientation will meet with deans from the Office of Student Affairs Tuesday, Sept. 7. The BCC students will meet from 1:30 to 4 p.m. at Eastport Hall and UMO students will meet from 6 to 9 p.m. in the Memorial Union.

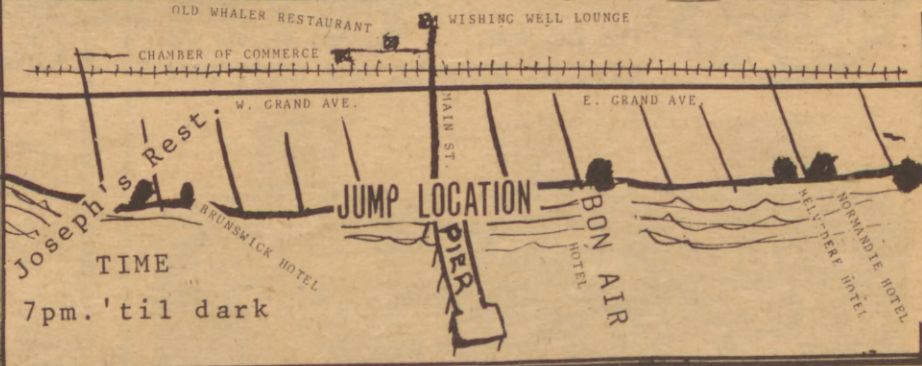


