Police Academy Graduation - May 19, 2017

Maine's 52 newest police officers have graduated from the Maine Criminal Justice Academy in Vassalboro. The officers spent eighteen weeks in study and training and most will begin patrolling immediately, in time for Christmas and New Year's Eve enforcement efforts .

Cumberland County Sheriff Kevin Joyce was the guest speaker who told the new officers that law enforcement is an honorable profession. "You'll see the best and the worst of people in your career, and each one of you will have a hand in making your communities safer than yesterday," Sheriff Joyce said.

The new officers studied many topics, including crime scene processing, emergency vehicle operation, first aid, traffic and criminal law, domestic violence and sexual assault.

Among the graduates were eight State Police Trooper recruits and Maine Marine Wardens, who will continue training with their departments before patrolling on their own.
