To the Honorable John H. Reed, Governor, and
Members of the Executive Council:

I respectfully submit a report showing the tabulation of
the Primary Election Vote of June 12, 1962.

At the Republican Primary Election in the County of
Andrusburg, Frank E. Carroll of Louisiana was a write-in candidate
for the office of State Senator.

According to the official tabulation of the vote, he
received 373 votes with a total of 403 required to qualify for a
place on the General Election ballot. He consequently asked for a
recount and the same was held on July 19, 1962.

A mistake in his favor was discovered in one of the wards
in Andrusburg and his correct total was 404, which, being more votes
than required to qualify, the recount was terminated.

The official tabulation has been changed in accordance
with the facts and this report submitted in compliance with the
provisions of Sub-section V of Section 127 of Chapter 3-A of the
Revised Statutes.
