1819 Maine Constitutional Election Returns: Plantation One

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At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of plantation
No 1 in the County of Oxford qualified to vote for Senators
Holden on the first Monday of December being the
Sixth day of said month 1819 for the purpose
of giving in their votes in writing expressing their
Approval or Disapprobation of the Constitution
prepared by the Convention of Delegates assembled
at Portland on the Second Monday of October last
pursuant to an act entitled an act relating to the
Separation of the District of Maine from Massachu-
setts proper and forming the same into a
separate and independent state

The whole number of votes given in in said
plantation were sorted and counted in open meeting
of the plantation by the Assessors who presided
at said meeting and were Eighteen of which the
whole were in favor of the Constitution as prepared
by the Convention as aforesaid and none were
opposed to said Constitution

The foregoing is a true copy of the record as
entered in open meeting in the books of the
plantation
