desirable or necessary -

We have also formed an Independent
Company of men who are drilling here - They
will not be enabled to meet the first call
of the State but when more are called for they
are ready to go - In such a case as this
can we borrow from the State some arms -
flint lock muskets - or whatever else you
may have that you do not need - for the
purpose of drilling and learning the exercise -
An early answer will oblige -
