

the census office has just issued a preliminary report of statistics of the daily press of the United States during the census year. Total number of journals in the country during the census year, 1902, which includes 80 dailies which suspended publication in 1901, 114 established in the course of the year. Aggregate daily circulation is placed at 3,581,125, and the aggregate annual circulation at 1,125,000,000. The people of the United States pay out for daily newspapers \$3,300,000 for their daily newspapers.
