To the Trustees of the Maine Insane Hospital,  
 In obedience to a provision of law, I herewith submit  
 a Report of the receipts and expenditures of the Hos-  
 -pital from March 31st 1849 to March 31, 1850,

The expenditures are as follows viz,

The amount of \$3553,42 paid for miscellaneous items appears large, but there is charged in that sum for clothing, repairs to furniture & bedding the sum of \$1849,28 leaving a balance of \$1704,14 to be charged as ordinary expenses of the Hospital,
