MAINE HORSE NEWS.

Maine horse news for the year ended at the close of the Maine records with the exception of the three-year-old record of Nelson, 2:24 and 2:25, in addition to the record of the 2:20 list of at least a dozen performers.

The best in New England for the year, will also be a hard mark to beat.

The following is taken from Dunton's Spirit.

"There never was a time in the history of the trotting horse when one fourth part of the number of stallions horses were sold as they are now. What does this mean? It means that men are making money in breeding trotting stock."

"Of all the States in the Union, Maine ranks next only to Kentucky and California as a trotting horse breeding State."

"The Pine Tree State has made a big forward stride in the horse business, as trotters of the animals bred here have become famous, and the number of them have increased."

"In the course of a year a large amount of money is left in this State by horse fanciers, who come from other States to purchase our fine driving and trotting horses that are famous near the country over."

"The demand for these horses is growing, and Maine horse breeders are determined to make the supply as nearly equal the demand as possible."

"What does this mean? It means that men here in Maine are making money in breeding trotting stock, and that the number of stallions horses is being kept up in the future a big revenue is to be derived from this source by our citizens."
