Dear Gov.

Great Complaints have been made in this section of the State of the irregularities in the payment of moneys allotted by the Volunteer Soldiers for the benefit of their wives & friends. These irregularities are of such a nature as to lead to the conclusion that something is wrong - that the Paymasters are making some improper use of the money and keeping the families of the Soldiers out of it. I have written to the Paymaster Genl respecting it but I thought a line from you would be likely to be more effectual.

I recd a line from George J. Brewer of Company D. 18th Me Regt saying that the 2^d Lieut. of that Company has sent in his resignation making an opening for his promotion. This is the same young man I note you respecting his promotion if any vacancy should occur. He is a most active intelligent young man. I enclose his letter to me.
