Dr Sir -

Permit me to introduce to you
Mrs Ellen R Swan - widow of Lt Henry Swan
2^d R. I. Infantry - who died in the service -

Mrs Swan visits Augusta on particular
business - she resides in Boston - her mother
resides here - Sir a widow - she has one son
in the 9th Me - Cavalry (R), now - her only
remaining son Daniel Fitzpatrick who is
but a few months past 17, years of age has
recently enlisted in the New England Cavalry
here, under Henry Farrar - & Daniel is now
at Augusta - Mrs Swans Mother has never
consented for Daniel to enlist - & wishes him
released - as he is less than 18, he should
be - he will be required, of course to be
bound all bounty - clothing &c -

Mrs Swan goes for her Mother & will relate
all the facts of the case - Please do all
you can for them - they are not able to be

to much expense in the matter - & as the
mother has before this sent all she has -
her son should be shared to her -
any thing you may do, for Mrs
Swan will be regarded a favor to me -
