Neck. ~~Long & thick~~ Large - strong. Free from blemishes

Chest. ~~Small~~ Large. Muscular. Expands equally.

Abdomen. ~~Flat & undeveloped~~ Strong. Free from marks.

Genital and Urinary Organs. ~~Undeveloped~~ Are right.

Vertebral Column. ~~Slight, wanting in firmness & growth~~ Straight strong & supple
