

The Judiciary Committee, to which
was referred the Resolutions of the Gen-
eral Assembly of Alabama, transmitted
by the Governor, touching the Controversy
between the States of Georgia and Maine,
relating to the refusal of the latter to deliv-
er up certain persons charged with offen-
ses against the laws of Georgia, have
had the same under ~~the~~ consideration,
and respectfully ask leave to make the
following Report,

That they are duly sensible of the diffi-
culty and delicacy of the question present-
ed under its various aspects; and also
of the respect that is due to the rights and
sentiments of coequal members of this
confederacy, upon points to which they
may each, in their own view, attach per-
manent and even vital importance; -
and ~~the~~ more, ^{so} upon which they may be
equally entitled to judge, ~~without any~~
~~ulterior resort~~, so long as there shall be
no ^{acknowledged} intermediate authority, or umpirage, ~~re-~~
~~known~~ ^{acknowledged} to determine questions between them
