Dear Sir,

Daniel Fitzpatrick enlisted with me a few days since and told me at the time I enlisted him that he was twenty one years old and was ready to take oath to that effect. He signed the enlisting papers affirming that he was 21.

At the time of his enlisting I paid him \$2.00 which he said he was in want of. Should you think proper under the circumstances to let Fitzpatrick go, you have my consent to do
