Fall Back!
President Grant influenced by others, has made several appointments that have not commended themselves to the country, but he has never made so thoroughly disreputable as that of Mr. Simmons to be collector of the port of Boston. Indeed it is so infamous that no congressman at Washington except Gen. Butler who glories in what would be shame for other men, dares stand as a sponsor. Every Republican paper in Massachusetts denounces and rebukes him, and even the personal organ of the Essex statesman sings the praises of Senator Simmons mildly and makes Senator Boutwell responsible for the outrage of the appointment. Now what does this mean? Every congressman from Massachusetts except Messrs. Butler and Boutwell declines to support him, and his delegation make haste to say that they have no part or lot in this matter. Has it then come about that Gen. Butler has power with the President that no other man has? We cannot think this; but rather suspect that Gen. Grant has been imposed upon and deceived by the claque of Gen. Butler. It is said that he has been represented that the merchants of Boston were favorable to the nomination of Mr. Simmons. Perhaps the merchants of Boston are so represented.

Who is this man Simmons? The question need be answered by saying that he is a creature of Butler, who has been the admiral of his master by his unscrupulous devotion to his interests and the practice of that chicanery in politics that only scoundrels resort to. William A. Simmons is the man who gave Butler the Boston delegation to the State Convention by disfranchising thousands of registered voters, and by a mature and unprecedented call for the caucus as chairman of the city committee. He is a young man of thirty-five years of age, who has been schooled in managing the caucuses of the slums of Boston—an unscrupulous wire-puller, a political scoundrel.

It is said that he has proved an efficient Supervisor of the Internal Revenue, that he has faithfully and economically discharged his duty. This may be true though we confess a decided preference for men differently educated and having other associations. We object to a man for any position who has, in contempt of public opinion, perpetrated unblushing frauds. Such a man, if appointed, is a temptation, high-minded, or above temptation.

Besides the personal objections to Supervisor Simmons, it is not too much to say that the Republican party has had enough of Butlerism. They will not stand any more of the outrages of this kind, and will no longer countenance the men who are debauching the public service. Indeed such is the state of the public mind on this subject that there would be no man who would risk the reputation of those who take the risk of recognizing him as a leading Republican.

The demonstrations yesterday in Boston and on the roads of this State, and the protests of the Board of Trade of Boston and the honest indignation of the men who gave character to the city, indicate the unpopularity of the man and sound the death-knell of Butlerism. The indications now are that the President will withdraw the nomination and substitute the name of some man of decent reputation. We trust that this will be done. We cannot see how Gen. Grant can do otherwise.

In this connection, duty compels us to speak of another matter. When Mr. Simmons was nominated for Collector, Mr. J. H. Manley of this State, "intimated" and recommended by the Maine delegation as his successor. Mr. Manley is a pleasant gentleman and we have nothing but the best of feelings toward him. It is therefore exceedingly painful for us to speak of him in a way that is unkind, but we should be derelict to duty as a State press, and but a mere personal organ, should forbear to say to our Congressmen that the intelligent rank and file of the organization in Maine will not approve their action in this matter. We are not disposed to go into the past. We do not question Mr. Manley's efficiency as a Treasury agent, but we, in common with thousands of other citizens, are on the ground that he believes in Gen. Butler and that it is the first duty of a federal official to devote his time, not to the public service, but to wire pulling to secure the success of the man or men who give him public office.

So long as they are clean, high-toned and patriotic men we care not whether they are patriot of Boston or Representative of Internal Revenue; but as a Republican journal it is our duty to warn the men who are disposing of the offices of the country, that they must "unleash" the organization of its Simmons supporters and the like. Speaking for the men who have stood by the side of Mr. Manley for years, and who claim as their own his brilliant record, we say to the adherents of the Butler school of politics fall back!

The municipal election in Philadelphia that resulted in the re-election of Mayor Stokely, Republican, by a vote of 10,000 to 9,000, is a matter of some interest. The Philadelphia Press under the present government has an unpleasant reputation, and should we believe *Press*, it is the worst possible. If there had been a good man to oppose to Mr. Stokely we should have been glad to have him succeed; but a Reform party that has been so long forward as its standard bearer, causes one to doubt its genuineness. He has been for years notorious for his political intrigues and general badness, and we have no more hope of him than for Gen. Butler. Of course both parties will assert that they were cheated and probably both did their best at it. Pennsylvania reform is not yet developed.

The latest intelligence from Boston is that at the solicitation of the Board of Trade and other prominent citizens, Judge Russell has consented to withdraw his resignation, and that fact has been telegraphed to the President. Hundreds of letters have been sent to Washington protesting against the appointment of Simmons, and the wires have been loaded down with despatches to the Massachusetts delegation praying for the defeat of Simmons. One thing is certain, this last powder shot of Gen. Butler has ruined him in Massachusetts politics.

The Washington special of the Kennebec Journal announcing the nomination of J. H. Manley of Augusta to be Supervisor of Internal Revenue, is a little premature, we think, as it does not appear in any other paper. The Maine delegation, the special of the Boston Journal says "guardedly recommended" Mr. Manley's nomination for Supervisor and he was endorsed by the Commissioner of Internal Revenue.
