My dear Gov:

Humphrey E. Eustis of
Dixfield in your State was one of my
very best soldiers during my three months
"service" with my company a year ago.
He is now "recruiting" men in Maine
with the expectation of receiving a Lieuten-
ants Commission; and his brother in
Boston, who was then (and is now)
a member of my company, has asked
me to say a good word to you for
Humphrey. This I do most cheerfully,
and I assure you he is a noble and
gallant soldier: of good stock; and
if I were going into the service again
I should feel myself fortunate in having
him for first Lieutenant. He will do
full justice to any position which he will
accept.
