Cowan Esq, in behalf of said Company and by the unanimous vote of the Company at a meeting held at the City Hall on Tuesday Evening April 24, do hereby tender the services of said Company to the State, and express the desire of its members to be called at once into service to aid in meeting the Requirements of the President of the United States on the Part of Maine, and the Committee do also in accordance with a vote of the Company request the members be organized into a Rifle Corps, if practicable, if not into an Infantry Company.
