# *Maine— The Way Life Should Be.*

Mountains, forests, lakes, the ocean — your vacation in Maine can be whatever you want it to be. Take a stroll at sunset on a secluded beach, or an exhilarating morning hike up a wooded mountain trail; a heart-thumping whitewater rafting adventure, a concert by the sea, or a romantic gourmet dinner in town. Your memories of the beauty and tranquility you'll experience here in Maine will be with you long after your pictures are developed.

We have lighthouses galore, wide, white-sand beaches, and one-of-a-kind rocky coves where only the freshest seafood is served in restaurants. Travel to the past on a windjammer cruise or a ferry trip to an off-shore island, leaving the hustle and bustle behind for a day or a week. Ride a narrow gauge railroad train, see antique aircraft and wooden boats, visit Victorian homes turned into museums and working farms that welcome guests.

Explore mountains for climbing, lakes for swimming and boating, rivers to canoe for days, and hidden streams and ponds for the best fishing. 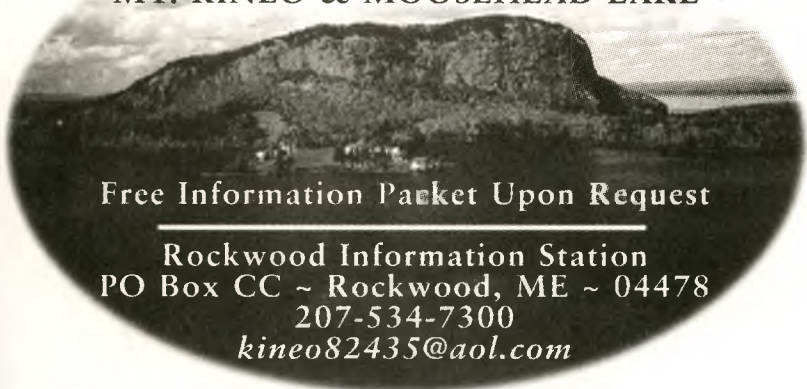

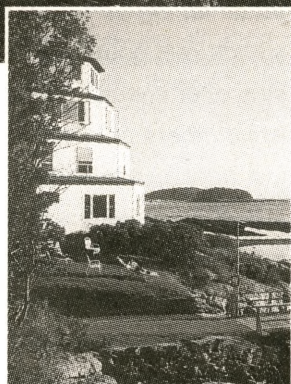

# *The Inn and Bed & Breakfast Experience*

A stay at an inn or bed & breakfast in Maine is always a special and memorable experience.

Maine has large and small, modern and historic inns, each one unique in style and amenities. A quaint island inn with ocean views might have rooms with fireplaces or Jacuzzi tubs. The larger, modern inns often have air-conditioning and cable TV, king- or queen-sized beds, and perhaps a heated pool. A smaller, lovingly restored Victorian inn furnished with antiques and original art may serve sumptuous gourmet breakfasts and afternoon refreshments. Some inns offer special menus. Some welcome children and even pets, while others are "adults only." Some are smoke-free. You'll find one just right for you in this guide.

Bed & breakfasts in Maine are most often older homes full of history and character. Get a great night's sleep under a handmade quilt in a quiet 1700s village home, after a day of cross-country skiing. Spend a weekend at a charming 1800s farmhouse with fireplaces, wide porches and herb gardens, or a week in a restored sea captain's home overlooking a rocky cove. Fill your days exploring beaches, eating lobster, hiking, fishing, sailing, and shopping the outlets and antiques barns. When it comes to breakfast, the specialties range from fresh Maine blueberry muffins to huge meals complete with steak and eggs. You'll find your perfect "home-away-from-home" in this guide.

More rustic cottages, while offering a very special experience, may be heated only by a woodstove or fireplace. One cottage will be on its own and "an easy walk to town and attractions," while another will be part of a colony, but right on the beach; some are available for short stays, and others rent only by the week or longer. Please read each description carefully to find just the right get away for you.
