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Population, 1960 and 1966 -
Permanent and Seasonal, by Minor Civil Divisions

The 1960 population was determined by the U. S. Bureau of the Census. The 1966 estimates were prepared by the Division of Research and Vital Records, State of Maine Department of Health and Welfare. The seasonal estimates were prepared by the Public Affairs Research Center of Bowdoin College.

Populations are estimated for July 1, 1966. Persons utilizing the estimates should understand that the method of estimation produces estimates which on the average contain relatively small errors. However, for individual minor civil divisions, errors in the estimates will result from sampling and other types of errors in the data.

Estimates for larger places will tend to be more precise than estimates for smaller places. In addition, there may be certain circumstances which make the migration estimation method less applicable than for others. For example, it appears that estimates for places with military reservations, colleges and universities, and certain other types of institutions may be less precise than for other places. In general the estimates are sufficiently precise for purposes of planning, particularly as they relate to larger areas of the State.

The seasonal population estimates (provisional) represent the maximum increment to the year-round population. Transients are not included.

County totals of permanent and seasonal population do not include any summer residents of unorganized territories.
