Dr Sir,

I find here, Albina B Allen,

a private, in 14th Reg Co (A) claims to ^{be} absent by reason of discharge. Said discharge is dated Augusta May 19, 1862, discharged "by reason of Surgeon Certificate of Disability," signed, of W T Gardner, Major Com U.S.A.

"Nason B Cunningham" a private of Capt Snrromans Co (E) 6th Me Reg - claims to be absent by reason of a discharge, said discharge is dated Aug 17, 1861

"by reason of sickness" signed Abner Knowles, Col 6th Reg Me Vol. - is well and able to work -

R. P. Grindle, a private in Co (H) 4th Me Reg - claims to be absent by reason of discharge - said discharge is dated Alexandria June 5th 1862. "by reason of Surgeon certificate of disability by order of Genl Wadsworth;" there is no signature to the discharge at the bottom is. Surgeon of U.S. Army} but no name above it. - (Health very poor lung complaint)
