Sir Sir,

George W Gray of Pinobscot of Capt Trask's
Co. E 4th Me. Reg. claims to be absent on Furlough
of four days from Augusta. Says 'before he could
get back the Reg had left and he thought he need
not go back. - says he will report himself at Augusta
immediately: is a stout able bodied man and says he
is perfectly well - he has no papers only a verbal
leave.

Amasa S Condon of Orland claims to be absent
by reason of discharge; a Corporal of Co. E Sixth
Me Reg. Discharge dated Philadelphia. July 16 1862
"by reason of Surgeon Certificate of Disability. by order
of Brig Gen Montgomery and signed "J. R. Freese
A. A. G.". health pretty good.

Also find here Thomas W Maggatt of Mt Desert
a private in Co H 4th Me Reg. claims to be absent
by reason of discharge. said dis is date Annapolis.
July 9 1862; by reason of great Pul disability and pulmonary
symptoms of Phthis. Pulmonalis. signed "J. M. F. Stanton
Col 67th Penn. Reg. Acting Comander - health very poor.
