Ordered.

That a joint Select Committee be appointed, consisting of three on the part of the Senate, with such as the House may join, whose duty it shall be to inquire into the expediency of re-binding certain Resolves relating to Slavery, approved, March 17, 1855, and that ~~certain~~ resolves relating to Kansas now on the table of the Senate be referred to the same Committee.
