Bangor June 19th 1864

Dear Sir,

I understand that the 2nd Maine Regiment is going to be filled up to 1000 men and that they are to be enlisted here. I wish to say to you that I wish you to authorize me to enlist them, and I will take charge of them my self and go to the seat of war with them; my self. I live here in the city. I am Sergeant in Capt Caff's Company, I have been waiting to see if there was any chance for our Company. Will you be kind enough to inform me if there is any

probability of raising another
Regiment here, for we are
spending for to go to war.
