I learned from
Vice Pres^d Hamlin on his return
home, that he presented the name
of my son, Frank W. Webster, now
a Corporal in Co D 1st Heavy Artill-
ery for a commission in one of the
colored regts about being raised
in L.A. and that you put down his
name with the promise that he
should have such position: but
Col Chaplin told me, he understood
you to say that you had taken but
two from that Co and that my son's
was not one of them: fearing there
was some mistake, and one which
^{might} be a disappointment to him, and
if so, that it might not now be too late
to remedy it, I venture to bring it to
