Bluehill Aug 23 1862

Dr Sir

I find on returning here from the East this M. one John J Storr a private in Co (B) Second Ill. Reg. claims to be absent by reason of discharge, dated Halls Hill Va Jan'y 18 1862. "by reason of disability" signed Chas W Roberts Col Comd. (health good) -

George W Clay a private in Co. A 6th Reg. claims to be absent on furlough, dated Albany N.Y. July 21 1862 and runs to Aug 21. 1862, signed J T Sprague. Maj 1st Inf. U.S.A. Mill Comd.

Clay is not yet able to travel and I herewith report send you certificate of his attending Physean - Clay is very anxious to return as soon as able. The Physeians Certificate you will observe has been sent to Boston Mass and returned -
